

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Thank you for participating in EBR 2020. The virtual program is designed as a mock exam, with case-based questions emulating the format and subject matter of the ABIM's Endocrinology, Diabetes, and Metabolism Certification Examination.

This course includes:

- comprehensive on-demand topical review sessions covering 220 case-based questions across the spectrum of endocrinology, including detailed answer rationale;
- ability to test yourself against your peers, with an individualized score report to identify areas to focus your studies;
- nine hours (three hours per day) of live topical Q&A sessions with the experts September 16–18, 2020; and
- the hard copy of *Endocrine Board Review 12th Edition (2020)*, containing all 220 case-based questions with complete answer rationale.

- Prepare your space with anything you might need during the virtual program (appropriate chargers, note-taking materials, water, etc.).


